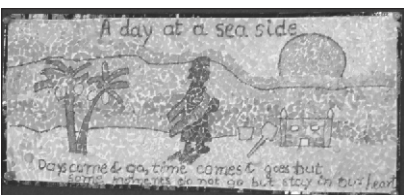
The Regents, once again, tried to prove their mettle in the ever creative "Drawing Competition" held on 30th April, 2011 in the
